Naval Academy Entrance Requirements

- Plan on walking onto base, only those with a proper DOD credential can drive on. Those on the bus will be precleared.
- Required for entrance: REAL ID Compliant Driver's License or State ID card, U.S. Passports & Passport Cards or Enhanced Driver's License (EDL). Visitors under the age of 18 without a valid ID must be escorted by a responsible adult with a valid ID.
- Visitors may undergo an ID and bag check and be screened through a magnetometer.
